Darden in discharge more or as shown by act and a note for the same do sell and convey unto him one mare colored Horse Mule named Leandrie To have and to hold to him the grantee and his heirs or assigns forever. I warrant this property free of incumbrances and fully release the right. It is agreed however that if the grantee or any representative pay to Jas. J. Darden or his representative the sum aforesaid on or before the 20th day of Decr. 1880 in redemption for the said Mule and until such payment shall not remove the mule or sell or trade him and in case of death of said Mule then conveyed, hold myself and heirs and assigns responsible
