Myrick or either of them to expose said property to Public Sale for cash. Witness the following signatures and Seals this 22nd day of June A.D. 1880

Andrew in supplies & services as shown by account at book for the same do Bill and convey unto him one Horse colored Brown Mule named Charlie, I do have and to hold to him the grantee and his heirs or assigns forever. I warrant this property free of incumbrance and fully refund the right. It is agreed however that I & the grantor or my representative pay to Jas. J. Andrew or his representative the sum aforesaid on or before the 20th day of Decr. 1880 in redemption for the said Mule and until such payment shall not remove the Mule on sell or trade him and in case of death of said Mule this conveyed, hold myself and heirs and assigns responsible
