This Agreement, entered into this 1st day of May 1880
between James M. Leebitt of one part and Hawk
Blunt of the other part, stipulates as follows:
That whereas the said Hawk Blunt is about to
engage in the cultivation of the soil and desirous
to obtain during the year 1880 advances in supplies
from the said J. M. Leebitt to the amount of
Ninety \$ all and beyond which limit the said
Hawk Blunt shall not go, and the said J. M. Leebitt
having agreed on his part to furnish the said
advances. Now the said Hawk Blunt on his
part in consideration of the above premises
does hereby grant a lien to the said J. M. Leebitt
on the crops which may be raised in the
year 1880 upon the lands in cultivation of which
the above amount of advances has been or
was intended to have been expended. This
lien is granted under an act of the General
Assembly of Virginia approved April 2nd 1872
entitled an Act to Secure Advances for
