James M. Corbitt of the one part and Frank Brett of the other part,
Witnesseth as follows; That whereas the said William Brett
is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is
desirous to obtain during the year 1880 advances in supplies
from the said J. M. Corbitt to the amount of thirty five
dollars, beyond which limit the said William Brett
shall not go, and the said James M. Corbitt having agreed on
his part to furnish said amount of advances. Now
the said William Brett, in consideration of the above
promises does hereby grant a Lien to the said James M.
Corbitt on the crops which may be made during the
year 1880 upon the lands in cultivation of which the
said amount of advances has been or was intended
to have been expended. This Lien is granted under
An Act of the General Assembly of Virginia
approved April 2nd 1873 entitled "an Act to secure
advances for Agricultural purposes." Witness of
