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This Deed, made and entered into this the eighth day of June A.D. 1880 between P. Ellis and Rebecca J. his wife grantors of the one part and John H. Harrison by grantee of the other part, Witnesseth as follows: That P. Ellis and Rebecca H. his wife grantors as aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, bargained and sold them in hand paid by the said John H. Harrison unto and by their separate do grant upon covenants, with the said John H. Harrison as aforesaid, with General Warranty, a certain lot or parcel of land at Bonaventure, District of South Hampton County, Virginia, commencing at a small elm in said Jms. H. Harrison's line and running down the County road to a small white oak in said P. Ellis' line, thence North west one hundred and forty yards to a large white oak, which is a corner line for the said Jms. H. Harrison and P. P. Ellis thence in a right line to the said Jms. H. Harrison's line and thence up said Harrison's line to the beginning containing three fourths of an acre, be the same more or less, together with all the estate, title and interest of the grantors of the first part, in and to the said land.
