This Deed, made this 11th day of July, in the
 year one thousand eight hundred and eighty
 between John W. Branch & Adelia P. Branch his
 wife of the one part, and Franklin Tice of the
 other part. witnesseth that the said John W.
 Branch & Adelia P. Branch do grant unto
 the said Franklin Tice the following property
 to wit all of a certain piece or parcel of
 land (a part of "Jordan tract") as conveyed
 by a Deed executed by Richard W. Clayton
 to said John W. Branch on the 10th day of
 January 1880 & lodged in the Clerks Office of
 Southampton County In Trust, to secure
 the payment of the sum of One hundred &
 thirty two dollars as mentioned below, viz.
 one Bond of Sixty Seven & 65⁰⁰ Dollars in
 favor of John W. Hedges pitch executed by said
 John W. Branch on the 24th May 1880, and one Bond
 in favor of A. W. Clayton \$65⁰⁰ executed by
 said John W. Branch on the 28th day of May 1880
 & secured by Richard W. Stephenson. In the
 event that default shall be made in the
 payment of the above mentioned Bond then
 the Trustee on being required so to do by John
 W. Hedges pitch & C. M. Stephenson aforesaid their
 successors or assigns, shall sell the property
 hereby conveyed. And it is covenanted and
 agreed between the parties aforesaid, that in
 case of a sale, the same shall be made after
 first advertising the time place and terms
 thereof for 20 days upon the following terms,
 wit: For Cash as to so much of the proceeds
 as may be necessary to defray the expenses
 of executing this trust, the fees for drawing
 and recording this Deed, if then unpaid,
 and to discharge the amount of money then
 payable upon the said Bonds above mentioned
 and if there be any residue of said purchase
 money, the same shall be made payable at such
 time and secured in such manner as the said
 John W. Branch & Adelia P. Branch executors
 administrators or assigns shall prescribe and
