 Witnesses, that in order to secure one note payable
 by the said Byrd and Jenkins unto W. H. Jenkins & Co
 they the said Grantors do grant and convey unto the
 said John W. Lawrence, Trustee aforesaid, the interest
 crop of Peanuts consisting of 20 acres more or less
 which they are cultivating on their farms in the
 said County of Southampton. In Trust, to secure
 the above mentioned debt payable and due
 unto the said W. H. Jenkins & Co as follows to wit
 one note dated June 19th 1880 for \$300 Dollars
 due and payable by the said A. O. Byrd and

 unto the said W. H. Jenkins & Co, the 1st day of Nov. 1880
 said note being made by the said Byrd and Jenkins
 in consideration of supplies furnished by the said
 W. H. Jenkins & Co from their Store in the Town of
 Fountains to assist the said Grantors in cultivating

 themselves to deliver said crop of Peanuts to
