This Agreement made and entered into this 23rd day of July A. D. 1880, between Thos. D. Barshaw and Pope & Gillette parties of the first part and Chesterfield Bowles of the other all of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia. Witness: That whereas, the said Chesterfield Bowles is engaged in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1880, from the said Th. D. Barshaw as follows one half of two and a half tons of Patapsco Lignite, not to exceed forty two dollars and fifty cents per ton, and a small amount he now holds against said Bowles for thirty dollars and supplies from the said Pope & Gillette in a running store account not to exceed five hundred dollars and the said parties of the first part having agreed (and already furnished in part) the above amounts if necessary to carry on the crops of the said Chesterfield Bowles, and in consideration of the above advances & promises the said Chesterfield Bowles goes hereby grant a lien unto the said Th. D. Barshaw and Pope & Gillette to the amount of above advances, on all the crops of every kind which may be made upon the land which the said Chesterfield Bowles does cultivate or has cultivated, and it is further agreed that the crops shall be cultivated and housed by said Chesterfield Bowles and delivered to the parties of the first part as they may direct and the said parties of the first part agrees that the said Bowles shall have the privilege to sell one bale of cotton to any one so he gets the cash to keep house the land if it becomes necessary to do so to get the cash in by the 20th day of Decr 1880.
