This agreement made and entered into this 23rd day
 of July A. D. 1880, between H. D. Barbau and Pope
 & Gillette parties of the first part and Chesterfield
 Bowles of the other all of the County of Southampton
 & State of N.Y. Witness. That whereas the said
 Chesterfield Bowles is engaged in the cultivation
 of the soil and is desirous to obtain supplies
 during the year 1880 from the said H. D. Barbau
 as follows one half of ten and a half tons of
 Patapco Iguana, not to exceed forty two dollars⁷⁵
 fifty cents per ton, and a small amount he
 may hold against said Bowles for Thirty Dollars
 and supplies from the said Pope & Gillette
 in a running store account not to exceed
 Seven hundred Dollars and the said parties of
 the first part having agreed (and already
 furnished in part) the above amounts if
 necessary to carry on the crops of the said
 Chesterfield Bowles, and in consideration
 of the above advances promises the said
 Chesterfield Bowles hereby grants a lien
 unto the said H. D. Barbau and Pope & Gillette
 to the amount of above advances, on all the
 crops of every kind which may be made upon
 the land which the said Chesterfield Bowles
 does cultivate or has cultivated, and it is further
 agreed that the crops shall be cultivated and
 housed by the said Chesterfield Bowles and
 delivered to the parties of the first part as
 they may direct, and the said parties hereby
 agree that the said Bowles shall have the privi-
 lege to sell one half of cotton to anyone so he
 gets the cash to help house the crop if it becomes
 necessary to do so to get the crop in by the 20th
 day of Decr 1880. Witness the following signature
