 This Agreement made and entered into this 4th day of May 1880 between Darden & Heyrick of the first part and Wm Barrow of the other part with-
 ss as follows, that whereas the said Wm Barrow is about to engage in the cultivation of the said and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1880 from the said Darden & Heyrick for the amount of One Hundred and Twenty Five Dollars, beyond which amount the said Wm Barrow shall not go, and the said Darden & Heyrick having on their part agreed to furnish said supplies now the said Wm Barrow on his part and in consideration of the above provisions doth hereby grant a lien to the said Darden & Heyrick on all the crops which may be made during the year 1880 upon the lands of which the said Wm Barrow cultivates for the above amount of advances which has been or was intended to have been expended. Now it is further agreed by the parties to this Agreement that the said Darden & Heyrick shall be first paid and satisfied, after which the balance if any shall be paid over to the said Wm Barrow. This Lien is granted under an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2 1782 entitled an act to secure advances for Agricultural Purposes. Witness the following signatures and seals.
