This Agreement made and entered into this 4th  
day of May 1880 between Darden & Mayrick of the  
first part and Wm. Barrow of the other part witness-  
eth as follows, that whereas the said Wm. Barrow  
is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil  
and is desirous to obtain supplies during the  
year 1880 from the said Darden & Mayrick for the  
amount of One Hundred and Fifty Five  
Dollars, beyond which amount the said Wm.  
Barrow shall not go and the said Darden &  
Mayrick having on this part agreed to furnish  
said supplies now the said Wm. Barrow on his  
part and in consideration of the above provisions  
doth hereby grant a lien to the said Darden & Mayrick  
on all the crops, which may be made during the  
year 1880 upon the lands of which the said Wm.  
Barrow cultivates for the above amount of advance  
which has been or was intended to have been  
expended. Now it is further agreed by the parties  
to this Agreement, that the said Darden & Mayrick  
shall be first paid and satisfied, after which  
the balance if any shall be paid over to the said  
Wm. Barrow. This Lien is granted under an  
Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved  
April 2, 1773 entitled and Act to secure advances  
for Agricultural Purposes. Witness the following
