day of July anno Domini eighteen hundred and
seventy nine between Littleton G. Powell and Bettie
his wife, Grantors of the first part and Jacob
Powell, Grantee of the second part all of
Southampton County and State of Virginia
Witnesseth as follows: that for and in consideration
of the sum of six hundred Dollars in hand
paid to the said parties of the first part by the said
John J. Powell, the receipt of which is hereby fully
acknowledged, the said Littleton G. Powell and
wife Bettie do hereby give, grant, bargain and
sell, and by these presents convey unto the said
John J. Powell, his heirs and assigns all that parcel
of land situated in the County of Southampton
and bounded and described as follows:
commencing at the bridge over Coopers Swamp,
running West to the lands of Joshua St. Powell
bounded on the North by the lands of Dr. Joseph
H. M. Sykes, east by William S. Francis
south by Littleton G. Powell and on the West by
Joshua St. Powell, containing or supposed to
contain two hundred acres, be the same
more or less. This land embraces all the land
which is now owned by the said grantors on
the north side of the road leading from the
bridge over Coopers Swamp to the lands now
owned by the said Joshua St. Powell.

To have and to hold the aforesaid premises
to the said John J. Powell, his heirs and assigns
to his and their use and behoof forever, and
we Littleton G. Powell and Bettie Powell said
grantors do covenant with the said John J. Powell
that they are lawfully seized in fee simple
of the aforesaid premises, that they are free
of all encumbrances, that they have a good
and lawful right to sell and convey the
same premises, and they will warrant and
defend the same against the lawful claims and
demands of any and all persons.
