Kindred (trustee) of the second, both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia as follows, that for and in the consideration of One dollar to him the said Parnell in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Parnell doth grant and convey unto the said Kindred one certain tract or parcel of land, said to contain Two Hundred acres be the same more or less lying in Southampton County and bounded by the lands on the north by R. D. L. M. Styles East by Wm. S. Francis South by Littleton G. Parnell and on the West by the lands of Joshua H. Parnell, This land is granted and conveyed
