This Agreement made this 14th day of May in the year 1880 between John F. Story of the first part, and Barham & Turner of the other part, both of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia: Witnesseth as follows: Whereas, the said John F. Story is engaged in or is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous that the said Barham & Turner shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which the said Barham & Turner has agreed to do. Now this Agreement Witnesseth: That the said Barham & Turner does hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said John F. Story, during the Present year, such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies (not exceeding the sum of one hundred & thirty dollars in amount) as may be needful to enable the said John F. Story to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the Present year. And the said John F. Story hereby gives and grants to the said Barham & Turner, a Lien upon all such crops as he may make the present year, to wit: Corn, Fodder, Hay, Grains, Cotton and all other crops, also 10000 Shingles & one black mule, reserving fifty five dollars out of same in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made, not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved April 2, 1873. Witness our hands this 14th day of May 1880.
