in the year 1880 between Abel Blow of the first
part and Barbam & Turner of the other part, both
of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia.

during the present year, such monies, provisions,
fertilizers and other supplies (not exceeding the
sum of \$15.00 fifteen dollars in amount)
as may be needed to enable the said Abel
Blow to cultivate and gather his crops proposed
to be made the present year. And the said Abel
Blow hereby gives and grants to the said Barbam &
Turner, a Lien upon all such crops as he may make
