This Agreement made this 6th day of August  
in the year 1880 between Levy Hicks of the first part  
and Barbara & Turner of the other part both of the  
County of Southampton, State of Virginia  
Witnesseth as follows. Whereas the said  
Levy Hicks is engaged in or is about to engage  
in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous that  
~~of~~ the said Barbara & Turner shall during  
the present year make certain advances to the  
said cultivator of the Soil, which the said  
Barbara & Turner has agreed to do. Now this  
Agreement Witnesseth: That the said Barbara  
& Turner does hereby promise and agree to  
advances and furnish to the said Levy Hicks during the  
present year, such manures, provisions, fertilizers and  
other supplies (not exceeding the sum of fifteen dollars  
(\$15.00) as may be needful to enable the said Levy  
Hicks to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be  
made the present year. And the said Levy Hicks hereby  
gives and grants to the said Barbara & Turner a lien  
upon all such crops as he may make the present year  
to wit: Corn, fodder, Peas, Beans, cotton and all other  
crops, in order to secure the payment for all such  
supplies and advances as may be actually made  
not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement
