This Agreement made this 10th day of July in the year 1880, between Joshua Irvine of the first part, and Barham & Turner of the other part, both of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia: Witnesseth as follows: Whereas, the said Joshua Irvine is engaged in, or is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous that the said Barham & Turner shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which the said Barham & Turner has agreed to do. Now this Agreement. Witnesseth: That the said Barham & Turner does hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Joshua Irvine, during the present year, such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies, not exceeding the sum of two hundred and thirty dollars in amount, as may be needed by or to enable the said Joshua Irvine to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year. And the said Joshua Irvine hereby gives and grants to the said Barham & Turner, a lien upon all such crops as he may make the present year, to wit: Corn, Peas, Beans, Potatoes, Cotton and all other crops in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made, not exceeding the sum above stated, also lien on 3 head hog.
