This Deed made and entered into this the 15th  
day of August 1880 between George Johnson  
a single party of the first part, and George Prayor &  
Sarah Prayor his wife parties of the second  
part all of the County of Southampton and  
State of Virginia. Witnesseth as follows: That  
the said George Johnson does hereby grant and  
bequeath unto the said parties of the second  
part all that certain piece or parcel of Land  
lying and being in the County of Southampton  
Containing (62) Sixty two acres more or less, and  
bounded and described as follows: to wit  
commencing at a Pine on the north near the  
Public Road, thence from said Pine in a southerly  
direction to a Tree in Cypress Swamp, thence  
down said Swamp in an easterly direction  
to a corner tree, thence from said tree  
northerward to an "Elbow Pine" thence east to a  
corner tree in Myrtle Branch, thence up said  
Branch to an "Elbow Pine" and thence from  
said Pine to a Pine near the Public Road.

The above described land is granted and  
conveyed herewith upon the following conditions  
and stipulations: Namely, that the said  
I. Prayor & wife shall take care of the  
said Johnson during his natural life that  
they shall feed clothe and comfortably provide  
for the said Johnson during his lifetime,  
and at his death, the said I. Prayor &  
wife shall provide the body of said  
Johnson with proper and decent burial.  
The said I. Prayor & wife are to have  
and to hold the said land during their  
natural life, And in case of the death  
of the said Prayor before his wife Sarah,
