

This Agreement made and entered into this 6<sup>th</sup> day of August 1880 between Pope & Gillette of the one part and Garrison Lanius of the other, all of Southampton  
Co. & State of Va. Witnesseth that whereas the said Garrison Lanius is engaged in the cultivation of the  
soil and is desirous to obtain supplies of the  
said Pope & Gillette during the year 1880 to the  
amount of Fifty Dollars, and the said Pope  
& Gillette having agreed to furnish said  
supplies, and for and in consideration of the  
above advances & promises the said Garrison  
Lanius doth grant a lien to the said Pope &  
Gillette on all the crops which may be  
made by him during the present year 1880.  
To the amount of above advances. Witness

This Deed made this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of February one  
thousand, eight hundred and seventy seven (1877) between  
Alfred S. Stephenson of the one part, and Hansel Johnson  
of the other part all of the County of Southampton State  
of Virginia. Witnesseth: that in consideration of the  
sum of one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00)  
the said Alfred S. Stephenson doth grant unto the  
said Hansel Johnson, with General Warrant, all  
of his right title and interest to a certain parcel  
of land containing fifty acres more or less, it  
being a portion of the land bought of Murdock  
Stephenson and bounded as follows: Commenc-  
ing at a pine corner on Jacob Branch's line, and  
the Old Road thence along said road to a pine  
corner, thence along a line of marked trees N. West  
to Millfield Branch cornering on a Black Pine,  
thence up Millfield Branch to Thig Road,  
thence up said Road to Jacob Branch's line, corner  
pine, thence along Jacob Branch's line, commencing  
at a pine at the commencement. We true the following:
