Know all men by these Presents that I Chas. H.
William of the County of Southampton Virginia
of the sum of Seven Thousand Dollars
Dollars advanced me by Dr. W. H. Nicholson
in supplies, Merchandise &c borrowed as shown
by due bill and accounts for the same, do sell
and convey unto him, the following property to wit:
my horse bought of Dr. W. H. Nicholson, young colt
of corn, cattle, Peanuts & so on made up 1880
to have and to hold to him the grantee, and
his heirs or assigns forever. I warrant this
property free of all encumbrance and
fully defend the right. It is agreed, however,
that if the grantee, or my representatives, pay
unto Dr. W. H. Nicholson or his representatives, the
sum above named, on or before the 15th day of
December 1880, in redemption for this property (and
until such payment shall not waste, destroy,
injure, sell or remove the same, and in case of
injury or death from any cause, of any cattle,
horses, or hogs, there conveyed, hold myself, heirs
and assigns responsible for the full value
thereof, retaining all Homestead exemptions)
this these Presents, and everything herein
contained, shall cease and be void, otherwise,
remain in force and effect. On Default
in the foregoing conditions the grantee or his
representatives, may sell the above property at
auction, at any time, after ten days notice
to the grantor, retaining the sum of money
secured above, and all cost and charges of
the sale, rendering the surplus, if any, to the
grantor or his representatives.

It is agreed, also, that until default of these
conditions, the grantor may retain possession
of the property, and that the grantee or his
representatives may purchase at any sale made
at aforesaid time my hand and seal the 18th day of May 1880.
