This Lease, made this 23rd day of August 1880, between J. B. Prince of one part and B. P. Vick of the other part, Witnesseth: That the said J. B. Prince has leased unto the said B. P. Vick for the period of three years, dating from Jan'y. 1. 1881, the tract of land upon which the said Vick now lives, it being the land bought by J. B. Prince of B. C. Morris. And in consideration of said lease, the said Vick agrees & covenants on his part to pay unto the said Prince/ as rent on or before the 1st day of Jan'y 1882. \$2.00, and on or before Jan'y 1. 1883. \$2.00. and on or before Jan'y 1. 1884. \$2.00. The said Vick agrees to keep the same in good condition, and should he cultivate any of the same, for two consecutive years in 1880, he also agrees to manure the same the second year. The said Vick also agrees to manure all the same he may cultivate in 1880 or 1881. It is agreed that at the expiration of this lease or at any time during its continuance, if the said Vick should so desire, he may extend the time hereof to five years upon the same terms as herein before set forth.
