This Deed made the twenty eighth day of June in the year 1880 between J. B. Prince, Trustee, of the first part, Wm. H. Holmes of the second part and Wm. Morris, C. S. Morris and Frank Morris late partners in trade under the style of W. B. Morris and of the third part. Whereas by Deed dated December 18: 1875 the said Wm. H. Holmes conveyed to the said J. B. Prince Trustee the following real estate to wit: one lot of land together with the Store House and water house situated thereon in the village of Butler, County of Southampton, containing about two acres be the same more or less, and bounded by the lands of R.
