

Exam^d This Deed, made the 28th day of June in the
 year 1880, between Joseph B. Prince, Trustee of the
 first part W. H. Holmes, parts of the second part,
 and W. H. Morris, Frank Morris and L. S. Morris,
 parts of the third part. Whereas by a deed dated
 the 21st day of July in the year 1874, and of record
 in the Clerk's Office of the County Court of
 Southampton County, the said W. H. Holmes in
 order to indemnify and secure the said
 W. H. Morris, Frank Morris and L. S. Morris from
 any loss they might sustain by reason of the said
 W. H. Holmes not having contributed in money
 to the capital stock of the firm of which he is
 a member, all of which will more fully
 appear by reference to the said Deed, did convey
 in trust to the said Joseph B. Prince, Trustee, certain
 property set forth and described in said deed,
 as follows: a certain parcel of land situated
 in Southampton County, near the village of
 Berlin, containing $7\frac{1}{2}$ acres, to the same
 more or less bounded north by the lands of
 W. D. Butler, east by Jerusalem and Smithfield
 Road, south by Brecken's Road and west by
 the lands of Frank Vick, and a certain store-
 house lot in Southampton County, in the village
 of Berlin containing $1\frac{1}{2}$ acres of land,
 to the same more or less bounded north by the
 land of W. D. Stephenson's estate, east by the
 lands of W. H. Holmes, south by the lands of
 W. H. Holmes and west by the Jerusalem
 and Smithfield Road, and whereas the
 said firm has been this day dissolved, by the
 withdrawal of the said W. H. Holmes, therefore
 and no loss has been sustained by reason of
 his not having contributed in money to the
 capital stock as aforesaid, and the said
 W. H. Holmes desires the said property to be
 released to him. Now therefore this deed
 in consideration of the said Joseph B. Prince, Trustee
 with the consent of the said W. H. Morris,
 Frank Morris, and L. S. Morris testified to by
 this becoming parties to this Deed, and signing
 and sealing the same, doth grant and release
 with special Warrants unto the said W. H. Holmes
 and his heirs assigns, the said property hereinafter
 mentioned and described. And the said
 W. H. Morris, Frank Morris and L. S. Morris release to the
 said W. H. Holmes all their claims upon said
