

in the corner of Duvans land a straight course to the Spring at the head of the Branch between the two tracts and along the meanderings of that Branch to the Channel of Big Branch which separates this from Kirby's and which is bounded as follows: On the north by Duvan's land, on the east by the Bailey tract (now Rocco boundaries), on the South by the Big Branch and on the west by Duvan's land. To have and to hold the above described lands unto the said Emma Blackwell her heirs and a general forever with all the appurtenances.
