Whereas by a decree of the November Term of the Circuit Court of Southampton County, 1878, Luther P. Edwards was appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose of selling certain lots or parcels of land lying near the Town of Beaufort held by him in trust for May & Beaumont & children and whereas the said Luther P. Edwards did, in pursuance of said decree, the 18th day of October 1879, sell said land to the highest bidder and whereas at said sale John Pittman did become the purchaser of certain lots sold under said decree to wit Lot No. 3 he having bid the sum of \$228 or therefor, Lot No. 5 he having bid the sum of \$15.00 therefor, Lot No. 10, he having bid the sum of \$55.00 therefor, Lot No. 12 he having bid the sum of \$36.00 therefor and Lot No. 17 he having bid the sum of \$40.00 therefor aggregating for the purchase of all of said lots the sum of \$510.00 and whereas the said sum of \$510.00 has been fully paid unto said Luther P. Edwards by the said John Pittman, now therefore This 6th day of March 1879, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine, between the said Luther P. Edwards (Special Commissioner) grantor of the first part and the said John Pittman, & grantees of the second part both parties of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, It is witnesseth that in consideration of the payment of the said sum of Five hundred and ten dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, by the said Luther P. Edwards doth bargain, sell, grant and convey with Special warranty unto the said John Pittman & the above mentioned parcels or lots of land situated and bounded as follows: First: Lot No. 3 bounded on the west by the extension of Clay Street 2 chains and bounded on the south by lot No. 2, 14 chains, on the east by lot No. 7, 2 chains and on the north by lot No. 4, 14 chains, the southern boundary commencing on said Clay Street and 14 chains in a northwardly direction from the corporate limit of said Town of Beaufort said lot containing about $\frac{1}{16}$ of an acre more or less. Second: Lot No. 5 situated and bounded as follows: commencing at the intersection of Clay and Beaumont Street on the north side of Beaumont Street, thence in an easterly direction along Beaumont Street four chains to Lot No. 8 thence 2 chains ~~more or less~~ to a point on the ~~south~~ ^{west} corner of a lot bounded with Clay Street, ~~and~~ ^{and} ~~Beaumont Street~~ ^{and} ~~a~~ ^{the} corner of a ~~lot~~ ^{lot} ^{in a westerly direction} along Clay Street to the corner of Clay and Beaumont Streets the point of beginning and containing by estimation $\frac{1}{16}$ acre more or less. Third: Lot No. 10 situated and bounded as follows: Commencing at a point on Beaumont Street 2 chains 44 links in an easterly direction from the eastern boundary of Lot No. 5, thence
