grantors aforesaid, do grant, convey, bargain &
sell with general Warant unto the said
R. D. Vaughan the following real property, to wit:
a certain parcel or tract of land lying and

and bounded as follows: to wit: on the

Lawn Bratt, east by the land of Sam Beale,
South by the lands of Sam Beale, and Robert
Dawson, and west by the rear of the Cedar
