Vaughan, the 25th day of December 1880 unto Elisha B. Bradshaw And should the said P. D. Vaughan make default in payment of either of said bonds when payment is demanded, then it shall be the duty of said Trustee to advertise the sale of said land for the term of 15 days at two or more public places in said County at the expiration of which term, he shall sell said tract of land for cash, and apply the proceeds of sale as follows: First, he shall deduct from said proceeds all legal expenses of said sale, including & per centum of cost of sale for said Trustee, Second, he shall apply the remainder of proceeds first to the payment of the bond of \$800 due by said Vaughan unto Am.
