Grand This Indenture made this 22nd day of July, 1881
between Thomas Scott and Susanah Scott his
wife of the first part and Irooms H. Barnes
of the second part all of the County of Southham-
pton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth: That the
said Thomas Scott and Susanah Scott his wife in
consideration of Two Hundred & Eighty five
Dollars to them in hand paid by the said
Irooms H. Barnes, as and before the sealing and
delivery of these presents (the receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged) have bargained, sold and
by these presents doth bargain & sell unto the said
Irooms H. Barnes, his heirs & assigns, one certain
tract of Land lying & being in Southampton County
adjoining the lands of Jethro Cobb on the east
Edwin Daughtery on the South, Joseph J. Darden
on the west, and Rost Bawls on the north containing
one hundred and fifty acres more or less. To have
and to hold the same with all its appurtenances
thereunto belonging unto the said Irooms H. Barnes, his heirs & assigns
forever, with general warranty, clear from and
