This Deed made this 24th day of September 1880 between Wm. H. Jenkins of the County of Southampton State of Virginia, grantor of the first part and R. H. Norfleet of the same County and State chosen as Trustee of the second part witnesseth That in order to secure the sum of One thousand dollars the purchase price of a certain lot or parcel of land to be hereinafter described the said Wm. H. Jenkins Grantor of aforesaid doth grant and convey with General Warranty unto the said Norfleet the following real property lying and situate in the Town of Franklin in the said County and State and bounded as follows: Commencing on the north side of 11th Avenue and 103 feet in an easterly direction from High Street thence in an easterly direction from High Street along 11th Avenue 30 feet thence in a northerly direction along a line parallel with High Street about 300 feet to the line of the Putlaw farm thence in a westerly direction along the line of the Putlaw farm to a point 103 feet from said High Street thence in a southerly direction along a line parallel with High Street to 11th Avenue the point of beginning and containing about $\frac{1}{3}$ acre more or less and known and described on the Map of Franklin as Lot 760 together with all improvements and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Norfleet.
