 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by me,
 the said Burgess W. Herring have granted, bargained and
 sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and
 sell unto the said Charles B. Crompler the following
 property to wit: All my crops (harvested and
 unharvested) grown by me during this year (1880)
 Eighteen hundred and Eighty consisting of Peanuts,
 Corn, Soda, Peas and Potatoes. To have and to hold
 the said granted and bargained Crops of Peanuts,
 Corn, Soda, Peas and Potatoes unto the said
 Charles B. Crompler his heirs, Executors, Administrators
 and assigns, to their only proper use benefit and
 behoof forever and I the said Burgess W. Herring do
 ouch myself to be the true and lawful owner of
 the goods and effects hereby sold, and to have in
 myself full power, good right and lawful
 authority to dispose of the said crops in manner
 as aforesaid, and I do for myself, my heirs executors,
 administrators and assigns hereby covenant and
 agree to warrant and defend the said crops unto the
 said Charles B. Crompler his heirs, Executors,
 administrators and assigns, against the against
 the lawful claims and demands of all persons
 whomsoever. In witness whereof I the said
 Burgess W. Herring have hereunto set my hand and
 seal this 9th day of October 1880.
