Crumpler of the County of Isle of Wight Va. the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by me, the said Bunge W. Herwin, have granted, bargained, sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Charles B. Crumpler, the following property to wit: All my crops (harvested and unharvested) grown by me during this year (1880) Eighteen hundred and Eighty, consisting of Peanuts, Corn, Pooder, Beans and Potatoes. Do have and to have the said granted and bargained crops of Peanuts, Corn, Pooder, Beans and Potatoes unto the said Charles B. Crumpler his heirs, Executors, Administrators and assigns, to their only proper use, benefit and behoof forever and the said Bunge W. Herwin do vouch myself to be the true and lawful owner of the goods and effects hereby sold, and to have in myself full power, good, right and lawful authority to dispose of the said crops in manner as aforesaid, and I do for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns hereby covenant and agree to warrant and defend the said crops unto the said Charles B. Crumpler his heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns, against the, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever. In witness whereof I the said Bunge W. Herwin have hereunto set my hand and seal this 9th day of October 1880.
