This Deed made this 20th day of Sept. 1880 between W. W. White, N. B. Ridley, R. P. Barham, W. R. L. Lott & James R. Tyler Trustees for Dgo to Smith Lodge No. 122 of the first part and James C. Sebrall, of the second part. Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of \$100.00 which has been paid out to the individual members of the Lodge, the said parties of the first part, do grant and convey with special warranty unto the said James C. Sebrall, a certain tract or parcel of land lying in Southampton County, being the same on which the Lodge Room now stands containing one half acre, and bounded as follows beginning at a stake near the north east corner of the house and running a direct line, a south easterly course along a new chopped line, to the Public Road, a distance of sixty one yards, thence up said Road, a westerly course thirty nine and a half yards, thence along a new chopped line, north westerly course sixty one yards to a stake, near the north west corner of the house, thence along a direct line to the starting point.
