 old gate and along the Cruf fence as it stood on the
 1st day of March 1872, to a small branch, thence
 across said Branch straight along the hedgerow as
 indicated by a line of pressed trees to a large Pine
 standing near the old path in a small branch, thence
 down said Branch to the lease line of pine, then down
 said run to Lemmings Branch, thence up said Branch
 to Peggy Pond line, thence along the line between
 the said Peggy Pond and said land to Loups Road
 thence along said Road to the beginning, containing
 by estimation one hundred and twenty acres,
 be the same more or less. It being the Tract of Land
 conveyed to James R. Kells by Deed of Bargain
 and Sale dated the 1st day of March 1872 from
 Samuel Kells and duly recorded in the Clerk's Office
 of Southampton County Va upon the 21st day
 of April 1872, reference to which Deed is
 hereby specially made, for a more particular
 description of said land. But a right of way
 of six feet & eight inches is expressly reserved by the
 parties to this Deed to John W. Kells. Witness the
