B. Pretlow, and whereas the said Bond has been fully paid and acknowledged by the said S. B. Pretlow signing and sealing these presents And whereas the said A. A. Holland is entitled to and desires a reconveyance of the aforesaid real estate free and discharge from the same aforesaid. Now this Deed made this 5<sup>th</sup> day of October Eighteen Thousand and Eighty between D. C. Wills, Trustee and S. B. Pretlow of the one part and A. A. Holland of the other part. Witneseth that for and in consideration of the above facts the party of the first part doth grant and convey to the said A. A. Holland the above mentioned real estate, free and discharged from the same of the aforesaid Trustee. Witneseth the following signatures and seals.
