B. Pettlow, and whereas the said Bond has been fully paid and ⁱⁿdischarged by the said J. B. Pettlow signing and sealing these presents And whereas the said A. A. Holland is entitled to and desires a reconveyance of the aforesaid real estate, full and discharge, from the lien aforesaid. Now this Deed made this 5th day of October Eighteen Hundred and Eighty between J. B. Wills Trustee and J. B. Pettlow of the one part and A. A. Holland of the other part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the above facts the party of the first part doth grant and convey to the said A. A. Holland the above mentioned real estate, free and discharged from the lien of the aforesaid Trust deed. Witness the following signatures and seals.
