Pittlow Trustee certain real estate therein mentioned and described reference to which said Deed is hereby specially made to secure the payment of a Bond for the sum of One Hundred Dollars due to G. B. Pittlow and whereas the said Bond has been fully paid as evidenced by the said S. B. Pittlow signing and sealing these presents, and whereas the said A. A. Holland is entitle to and desires a reversionary interest of the aforesaid real estate free and discharged from the heirs aforesaid. Now this Deed made this 5th day of October Eighteen Hundred and Eighty between J. D. Pittlow, Trustee and S. B. Pittlow at the one part and A. A. Holland of the other part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the above facts, the party of the first part doth grant and convey to the said A. A. Holland the above mentioned real Estate free and discharge from the heirs of the aforesaid Deed.
