Beaton one light Bay Mule about eight years old. To have and to hold the said Mule forever. And I do covenant with the said George E. Beaton that I am legally possessed of said Mule and will warrant and defend the title to the same against the lawful claims of any other person whosoever. Given under my hand and seal this 19th day of October A. D. 1880.
