This Deed, made this fourth day of November in the year 1880, between S. Lewis, of the County of Southampton, in the State of Virginia, of the first part, and W. H. Jenkins, Trustee of hereinafter mentioned of the second part. Witnesseth that the said S. Lewis doth grant with General Warranty unto the said W. H. Jenkins, Trustee the following property, to wit: all and singular the crops of peanuts of the said S. Lewis now on the farm whereon the said Lewis resides in the said County of Southampton, whether the said peanuts be growing or sown and in shocks or housed: W. Trust nevertheless to secure unto J. Holzbachman of the City of Norfolk, Virginia, the payment of a certain negotiable Note, of even date herewith, payable ninety days after date to the order of the said J. Holzbachman at the Bank of Commerce, Norfolk Va. made and signed by the said S. Lewis and being for the sum of Fifteen hundred (\$1500) dollars with interest thereon after the maturity thereof at the rate of six per centum per annum till paid. And upon this further trust that the said W. H. Jenkins shall immediately upon the delivery of this Deed to him, take possession of the property hereby conveyed and assume the control and management thereof and the said Trustee may employ the services of the said S. Lewis as his Agent to gather get in, clean and generally take all things necessary to prepare the said crop of Peanuts for market and upon the maturity of the said Note if the same be not then paid by the said S. Lewis, the said Trustee shall sell the
