

Whereas by Deed of Bargain & Sale bearing date the 20th
 day of December 1878 from John Pittlow Jr. and Emma B.
 his wife unto John C. Davis was conveyed in consideration
 of the sum of \$464 54^½ to be paid by the said John C.
 Davis a certain parcel or lot of land lying in the Town
 of Franklin, and whereas in order to secure the purchase
 lot to the above price of said lot the said John C. Davis did execute a
 written Deed of Trust on said lot of land, and whereas the object
 of the trust has been fully satisfied by the payment
 of the purchase price of said lot by the said Davis to
 said Pittlow: Am therefore This Deed of Bargain & Sale
 made this the 9th day of November 1880 between the said
 John Pittlow Jr. John C. Davis and Emma J. his wife
 Grantors of the first part and Mahala Crumpler grantee
 of the second part (all of the County of Southampton
 State of Virginia) witnesseth: That the said John Pittlow
 Jr. in consideration of the payment of the purchase
 price of said land and the said John C. Davis and
 Emma J. his wife in consideration of the sum of
 six hundred and twenty (620) dollars to them paid,
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do grant
 convey, bargain & sell the said Pittlow with special
 ty said Davis wife with general warranty grants
 the said Mahala Crumpler the above mentioned parcel
 lot of land lying and situate in the said Town of
 Franklin and bounded as follows: beginning at
 a point on the east side of High Street midway between
 fourth Avenue and the intersection of High Street
 with the boundary line of the lands belonging to
 Mary H. Julia C. Sarah D. J. D. S. B. Pittlow; thence
 along a straight line parallel with 4th Avenue in
 an easterly direction fifty five (55) feet; thence along
 a straight line parallel with High Street and standing
 in a westerly direction to the boundary of the said Pittlow
 lands, about one hundred and forty feet, thence along
 the boundary line of said Pittlow about fifty five to
 High Street, thence along High Street about one hundred
 and forty feet to the point of beginning containing one
 fifth acre more or less. This lot is designated on the
 map of Franklin as one half of lot no. 50 that half
 joining the said Pittlow's lands. And the said Davis
 wife covenant that they have an undisputed right
 to make this conveyance that they have done no act to
 encumber said property, and that they will make any
 further assurances necessary to convey unto the said
 Mahala Crumpler an undisputed title to said
 lot or parcel of land together with all improvements
 thereon situated. And trustee in the above
