Whereas, the act of the Legislature did by an act approved the 27th of June 1879 prescribing in what manner and on what conditions a householder or head of a family shall set apart and hold a homestead and personal property for the benefit of himself and family exempt from sale or debt except that in order to be entitled to the full benefit of a homestead exempt from levy, seizure, garnishing or sale, the said householder or head of a family shall declare the same of the property so set aside by Deed duly recorded.
