McClure may have of in and to all the Realty now owned by said Laura McClure lying being and situate in South Hampton County Virginia near Iron Station in said County being lands devised to said Laura McClure formerly Laura Beach and now wife of said George W. McClure by her uncle Joseph D. W. Summrell late of South Hampton County Virginia together with all the tenements hereditaments and everything thereunto pertaining to have the said George W. Summrell his heirs assigns forever to have and to hold free from all incumbrances and free from all claims of any and all persons claiming by or through them the said party of the first part or either of them forever. And the said party heirs of the first part covenant that they have the right to convey the above mentioned property and that they do hereby warrant the title to the same and will forever defend it in any court of law or equity free from the claims of any and all persons whomsoever.
