This Deed made this 24th day of August 1790 between Elisha Street and Margaret A Street, his wife, of one part and Saml J. Pomeroy of second part, witnesses, that in consideration of the sum of one hundred & twenty five dollars, to them in hand paid, the said parties of first part do grant & convey with confirmed warranty unto the said Saml J. Pomeroy all their right, title and interest in the land formally owned by 10^m Davis Dec, situated in Southampton Co 9th and bounded by the waters ^{Rock} the lands of Arvinton Henderson, James Edwards, John Smith and others, and containing a lot of 17 1/2 acres witness the following signatures & seals;
