Know all men by these presents that W^m B. Hatfield late of the County of Southampton and late of Virginia died on the 31st day of July 1889 leaving as Widow and two children as his heirs - to wit that T. M. E. Hatfield, Widow of the said W^m B. Hatfield deceased, being a householder and head of a family, do claim under an act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved June 17th 1791 prescribing in what manner and under what conditions a householder and head of a family may get a part and hold a Homestead and personal property, exempt from sale for debt, the following personal property to hold by myself and Mary Ann Hatfield, children of myself and the said T. M. E. Hatfield and Mary Ann Hatfield, children of myself and the said W^m B. Hatfield to wit: 1st two barrels of corn valued at forty four dollars (60¢ six hundred pounds of flax valued at six dollars) (4¢ forty bushels of peanuts valued at thirty two dollars) (1) one horse valued at fifty dollars (1) one cart and wheel valued at fifteen dollars (1) two cows and calves valued at twenty four dollars (1) set of plow and cart harness valued at three dollars together with all my household and kitchen furniture consisting of (1) two beds and furniture valued at ten dollars (1) one half day chair valued at three dollars (1) one sewing machine valued at thirty dollars and all of my crockery table ware and cooking utensils valued at twenty dollars. The value of all of the above named property not exceeding the sum of \$2,000 but valued at the sum of \$2,274.
