This Lease made this 9th day of December 1850 between J. B. Prince Guardian
 of the orphans of W. J. Gray dec. of one part, and Thos. H. Gray of the other part
 witnesseth, That in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars
 for annuities to be paid Janry 1st 1852, and every 1st day of Janry thereafter for
 five years, the said Prince hereby leases to the said Gray for the period of five years
 from Janry 1st 1851 all the land belonging to the estate of W. J. Gray dec. except what
 is included in the dower of Mrs. Gray, and the said Gray agrees to keep the
 fences & ditches in good order, and the last year of that lease should the ditch be
 filled with stock, the said Gray is not to be held responsible for same, should the land
 be sold, the parties who subscribe to perform the conditions hereof, and the said
 Gray agrees not to change for or ward of the orphans of W. J. Gray now four & no
 others from month to month, witness the following signatures & seals

This deed made this 15th day of October in the year 1850 between J. B. Prince (Guardian)
 party of the first part J. E. Etheridge & J. E. Etheridge Jr. doing business under the firm
 name of J. E. Etheridge & Son party of the second part & Wm. H. Morris party of the
 third party Whereas by a deed dated the 18th day of May 1850 and of record in the
 Clerk's office of Southampton Co. Va. Deed book 146 page 69 the said Wm. H. Morris
 in order is secure to the said J. E. Etheridge & Son the payment of a certain bond
 executed by the said Wm. H. Morris and payable to the said J. E. Etheridge & Son bearing
 date May 18th 1850 and payable four months from the 1st day of May 1850 and for
 the payment of the sum of sixteen hundred dollars, did convey in trust to the
 said J. B. Prince certain property sit forth and described in this deed as follows
 one steam saw mill located on the lands of J. Wm. Ridley's Co. way gone to
 five miles & Harris & fifteen hundred bushels of grain in favor of said
 Wm. H. Morris in Susan County and whereas the said bond has been fully
 paid and the said Wm. H. Morris desires the said property to be released to him
 now thus for, this deed is witnesseth that the said J. B. Prince in consideration
 of the premises, and by and with the consent of the said J. E. Etheridge & Son do
 hereby grant and release unto the said Wm. H. Morris all that certain property
 as follows, one steam saw mill located on the lands of J. Wm. Ridley,
