Witness by act done dated the 4th day of November in the year 1880 and record in the Clerk's office of the County of Southampton State of Virginia.

Deed of Sale

I, the said party of the first part do hereby sell and convey to the said S. Lewis party of the second part all his crofts of Peacemeat on his farm in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, where the said land lies has been fully paid and the said S. Lewis party of the second part desires the said property to be released to him, now therefore this deed witnesseth that the said W.H. Jenkins party of the first part in consideration of the premises and by and with the consent of the said J. H. Cutcher party of the third part best fitted by his becoming a party to this deed and signing and sealing the same doth grant and release with special warranty unto the said S. Lewis party of the second part and his assigns the said property herein before mentioned and described the said W.H. Jenkins party of the first part releases to the said S. Lewis party of the second part all his claims upon the property, with the following signatures and seals:
