

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 25th day December 1880 this report of commissioners appointed at the September Term last of this Court to assign to Mrs. Eliza S. Debull her Dwelling in the Clerk's Office (and the exceptions thereto having been withdrawn) the said report is confirmed and ordered to be recorded. And the Court doth establish the said assignment and order that the said G.A. Stiff hold the lands so assigned to her as and for her Dwelling as aforesaid.

The undersigned commissioners appointed at the September Term of the County Court of Southampton County, to assign to the estate of Eliza S. Debull, her Dwelling in the Clerk's Office of late husband, B.W. Debull, beg leave to report that having examined & valued all the lands belonging to the estate of said B.W. Debull, they have allotted the lands as the dwelling said to be of Eliza S. Debull, all that tract lying on the East side of the Cabin Point road bounds as follows: beginning at the intersection of the first branch north of the house with said road, thence up said branch to its head, thence a direct north east line to forked fence near the corner of the open land, thence a south easterly line to the head of branch in the old field, thence due south to W.W. Whiterlin, thence along Whiterlin's line (westly) comes to the Cabin Point road, thence along said side east to the point of beginning. They also will the dwelling & all the out houses on said tract above assigned, they also assign the privilege of obtaining all necessary firewood & fruit timber, from the unassigned portion of the said real estate, further the right of running the crop fence now running between the Dwelling & the adjacent tract they also give and grant to Eliza S. Debull the right to remove, or any house and the dwelling site, that she may deem necessary for her use, to any part of the unassigned lands belonging to the Estate for the benefit of said said Estate. In assigning the dwelling house to Mrs. Eliza S. Debull it is understood by the commissioners, that the timber already gotten for the purpose, shall be used in repairing the dwelling, & the cost shall be paid out of the whole estate before any division.
