The undersigned commissioners appointed at the September Term of the County Court
 of Southampton County to assign to Martha S. Sebell, her dower interest in the real estate
 of late husband, B. M. Sebell, beg leave to report that, having examined & valued all the lands
 belonging to the estate of said B. M. Sebell, they have selected two acres as the dower of said
 Martha S. Sebell, all that tract lying on the East side of the Cabin Point road, bounded
 as follows: beginning at the intersection of the first branch, north of the house, with said
 road, thence up said branch to its head, thence a direct north east line to forked line near the
 corner of the same land, thence a south Easterly line to the head of branch in the old field, thence
 due south to W. M. White's line, thence along White's line westerly, corner to the Cabin Point road,
 thence along said road to the point of beginning, they also with the dwelling & all the out houses
 on said tract above assigned, they also assign the privilege of obtaining all necessary fire wood
 & fuel timber from the unassigned portion of the said real estate, & further the right & privilege of
 running the crop fence now running between the Dower & the adjacent tract, they also
 give Martha S. Sebell, the right to consent to the removal of any house around the
 dwelling plot, that she may deem necessary for her use, to any part of the unassigned
 lands belonging to the estate, for the benefit of said said estate, in assigning the dwelling
 house to said Martha S. Sebell, it is understood, by the commission's use, that the dwelling
 already gotten for the purpose, shall be used in repairing the dwelling, & the cost shall
 be paid out of the whole estate, before any division.
