This indenture made this the 18th day of December 1890, between Richard Harris of the first part of the County of Southampton State of Virginia, and Robert Harris of that second part, of the County and State aforesaid; witness that the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of one hundred and thirty, five dollars in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, conveyed and sold, and their heirs with do grant, bargain and sell unto the said party of the second part his heirs & assigns, all that piece or parcel of land known as Billy Brown's old tract containing twenty six acres more or less, and about thirty acres more or less, of the tract known as on bounded as follows, commencing at the Plat Swamp where my old tract of land lying the Billy Brown tract, running south ^{thence along the line of the said Billy Brown's land} west along the said Billy Brown's land, to the first Brown's land to a marked corner, thence adjoining the land of Mrs. C. C. Pope down, west tract thence running north East from said corner along the edge line, as now exist, which is about twenty five acres, & both of this family grass yard, on my land, which includes the buildings, built by the said Robert Harris to the place of commencement between my old tract of land and the said Billy Brown tract, at the Plat Swamp, together with the appurtenances thereto belonging, and the said party of the first part, do covenant bargain and agree with the party of the second part, to warrant and defend the title to said tract of land in with the person of the said party of the first part his heirs with do his hands and seal this the 18th day of December 1890.
