

This indenture made this the 18<sup>th</sup> day of December 1890, between Richard Harris  
 of the first part of the County of Southampton State of Virginia, and West  
 Harris of that second part, of the County and State aforesaid; witness with  
 that the first party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of one hundred  
 and thirty five dollars in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby  
 acknowledged, have granted bargain and sold, and their heirs with do  
 grant bargain and sell unto the said party of the second part his heirs &  
 assigns, all that piece or parcel of land known as Pelly Brown's old tract  
 containing twenty six acres more or less, and about thirty acres more or less,  
 of the tract known as on bounded as follows, commencing at the Plat Swamp  
 where my old tract of land joins the Pelly Brown tract, running south  
 thereupon along the side of the Plat Swamp  
 west along the side of Pelly Brown's old tract, to the first Brown's land to a marked  
 corner, then adjoining the land of Mrs. C. C. Pope's old tract, thence running north East  
 from said corner along the crop line, as now exist, which is about twenty five yards, to the  
 the place of commencement between my old tract of land and the said Pelly Brown tract, at the  
 Plat Swamp, together with the appurtenances thereto belonging, and the said party of the first  
 part, do covenant bargain and give with the party of the second part, to remain and defend the  
 title to said tract of land in and to the said party of the first part his heirs with sit his  
 hands and seal this the 18<sup>th</sup> day of December 1890.
