This Deed made the 3rd day of October 1850 between Wm H. Hood trustee, party of the first part,
Mr. Barritt of the second part, and Franklin Vick of the third part, witness, by deed dated
the 5th day of December in the year 1850 and of record in the Clerk's office of the County of
Southampton the said J. A. Barritt, in order to secure to the said Franklin Vick the pay-
ment of a certain bond executed by said J. A. Barritt and payable to the said Franklin
Vick bearing date the 8th day of December 1850 and for the payment of the sum of one hundred
and eighty five and 7/8 dollars on the 3rd day of December 1858 did convey in trust to the said
Wm H. Hood certain property for and described as said J. A. Barritt's slaves, that is to say, a
certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton, known both
as the G. S. Jones tract situated on the River's end and bounded on the north by P. R. Lewis with
east by Geo. S. Davis south by A. S. Morris on the south by R. W. Branch, containing fifty acres
more or less, being the same tract this day conveyed, by Wm H. Hood trustee to said J. A. Barritt
and who with the said land has been fully paid and the said J. A. Barritt does now and
hereby release to him, his heirs or assigns this deed notwithstanding that the said Wm H. Hood
trustee is aforesaid, in consideration of the premises and by and with the consent of the said
Franklin Vick testifying his becoming a party to this deed and signing and sealing
the same, doth grant and sell unto the said J. A. Barritt all that certain tract of land
above described and known as the G. S. Jones tract, the said Franklin Vick paying
to the said J. A. Barritt all his claims upon said land.
